

## RIVER CITY ARCS NET SCRIPT (March 24, 2021 edition)

Good evening. It is 8:00 p.m., Wednesday, and time for the River City Amateur Radio Communications Society net. This net is for the members of River City ARCS and any other radio amateur operator who would like to participate *(DROP)*

This repeater is N6NA on 145.25 MHz with a minus offset and a PL of 162.2 Hz. *(DROP)*

This will be a controlled net. Regular members are asked to standby. Please do not transmit unless requested to do so by the net control operator. If an emergency should arise, and you need the repeater, please contact the net control by saying "break-break." A double break signifies emergency traffic. The net will standby for you until the emergency is terminated or the traffic is moved to another frequency. *(DROP)*

The net will call club members first followed by guests who would like to check in. Club members will be called in groups by the first letter in the suffix of their call sign. This is the first letter following the number in your call sign. After we call for check-ins alphabetically we proceed with check-ins on AllStar and EchoLink. *(DROP)*

Club members are asked to respond with their full call sign using the recognized ITU phonetic alphabet. I would also like each member to indicate the location from where they are operating. I will recognize each group before continuing.

We will start with: A through D, Please come now *[Acknowledge call signs of check-ins]*

Next, E through H *[Acknowledge call signs of check-ins]*

Next, I through M *[Acknowledge call signs of check-ins]*

Next, N through R *[Acknowledge call signs of check-ins]*

Next, S through V *[Acknowledge call signs of check-ins]*

Next, W through Z *[Acknowledge call signs of check-ins]*

Finally, club member check-ins on AllStar or EchoLink *[Acknowledge call signs of check-ins]*

Are there any late club member check-ins? If so please come now. *(DROP)*

We are now ready for guests to check in. I would really appreciate it if you would give me time to recognize each visitor as they check in. Will the first visitor please come now. *(DROP)*

Are there any other late check-ins or guests? *(DROP)*

This concludes the roll call and check-in portion of the net and the net is now open for traffic or relaying messages and announcements under the direction of net control.

Stations who wish to be placed on the list with announcements or questions for the net, please come now with your call sign. *(DROP) (Acknowledge each station for their announcement)*

We will now proceed with this week's discussion topic. Those who wish to leave for the ten meter net at 8:30 pm may do so. Our topic of discussion for today is: " \_\_\_\_\_ ?" *(Poll each check-ins for their response)*

Are there any other stations with traffic or messages for the net, last call? *(DROP)*

We wish to thank the River City ARCS members and visiting stations for their participation tonight.

We also thank the control operators and N6NA repeater users for standing by.
