Clarksburg Country Run

On November 11, 2012, the River City ARCS, with the help of some friends provided health and welfare communications for the 47th annual Clarksburg Country Run. This was about the 14th consecutive year that we have participated in this event. The run raises funds for the Clarksburg Community Groups that volunteer for the event. These include Boy Scouts, Fire Fighters, Cub Scouts, The Soccer Club and Clarksburg Schools.

At my last count there were over 1700 runners registered this year. The course is the scenic back roads along the river and sloughs through the farmlands behind the river town of Clarksburg. There are five events including a 20 mile, 10 mile, half-marathon, 5 Km, and a one mile run/walk for children. The half-marathon is a championship run and is used as a qualifier for marathons such as the California International Marathon.
