RADIO CLASSES

The Sheriff's Amateur Radio Program (SHARP) is sponsoring two ham radio licensing courses starting in April.

A Technician Class course will be held April 1st, 3rd, 8th, 10th, 15th and 17th, and the VE session will be on the 19th.

The General Class license course will begin on April 30th and then be held on May 3rd, 7th, 10th, 13th, 14th, 15th, and the VE session will be on the 17th.

All classes will start at 6:00 PM and end about 9:00 PM. VE Sessions start at 6:00 PM and may be preceded by a brief review.

The cost will be \$35 for each course and includes the book, the appropriate ARRL Licensing Manual with the test question CD-ROM. If you already have a book, the cost will be \$5.00. Cash is accepted, but we would prefer a check or money order made payable to "SHARP."

The cost for the exam will be the standard \$15 fee. Preferable method of payment would be a check or money order made payable to "ARRL VEC."
